The Bavarian Rule in Greece and the Foundations of the Modern Greek State and Society (1830-1843)

This lecture will focus in the transition between the Revolution and the setting of the foundations of the modern Greek state, roughly after the signature of the Protocol of London that certified Greek independence and till the aftermath of the revolution of the 3rd of September, 1843, that ended the absolute Othonian monarchy. Key points will include: the destabilization and the end of the Ioannis Kapodistrias government, the choice of Othon as the new King of Greece, the establishment of the Viceroys interim period (1833-1835), the years of the absolute monarchy (1835-1843), the setting of the foundations of the administrative, legal, military, educational, and ecclesiastical structures of modern Greece, the changes that took place in Greek society, the clash between the “*autochthons*” and “*eterochthons*”, the revolution of 1843, the Constitution of 1844, and the establishment of the “*Megali Idea*” (Great Idea) as the national ideology. The objective of the presentation will be to contribute to the understanding of the processes that transformed Greece from an Ottoman province to a model and ambitious Balkan and eventually European state.

Yannis Charalambidis is a journalist and historian specialized in Modern History. He holds a Bachelor’s degree in Greek history from the University of Crete, Greece, and he is enrolled in an MA Postgraduate Program in Modern Greek and European History at the same University. He has worked in multiple public history projects in the media and internet. He is currently the manager of Patris.gr, the web portal of “PATRIS”, the most historic and popular newspaper in Crete, Greece.

DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR JOINING HLM'S ONLINE LECTURE ON MARCH 16, 2025 AT 2:00 PM ON EITHER ZOOM OR FACEBOOK.

1) If you already have the Zoom application ("Zoom Client") installed on your machine, then you go through the following steps:

A. Click on the webinar link <https://us06web.zoom.us/j/87479094853>. A small "Launch Application" screen will appear. The screen will show the following: "Choose Other Application" and "Open Link" and "Cancel"

B. Click "Open Link"

A new screen will appear asking for your **email and name**.

If the system asks you to also provide the **Webinar ID**, enter the following: **874 7909 4853**.

C. Once you enter the required information, click "Join Webinar"

Once you have joined the webinar, familiarize yourself with the set of buttons above or below the screen.

One in particular, the "Q&A" button allows you to type questions for the speaker during or after the presentation.

2) If you don't have the Zoom application installed, clicking the above link will take you through an installation process first but since that is rather complicated, we recommend that you install Zoom first on your PC, laptop or tablet.

To **install Zoom** go to the following link:

Opening that link points to a download file (see down arrow pointing to the .exe file at the bottom of your screen) that you will have to accept (click on the "Keep" button) and then open (click on the file name) in order to download the Zoom client IF YOU ARE WORKING ON A PC OR LAPTOP.

IF YOU ARE WORKING ON A TABLET, the same page provides a link to **Apple Store** (button named "Download in App Store") for installation on iPad or to **Google Play** (for tablets other than iPad: in that case click on the "Download in Google Play" button)

Once you succeed installing Zoom (we recommend doing that before the event) then you can proceed with steps A, B, and C in the previous paragraph (1), right before the webinar, in order to attend.

3) If Zoom installation fails, either because you are running an old machine with an operating system that does not support Zoom (e.g. Windows Vista or any Windows OS earlier than Windows 7) or an earlier version of your browser, then you can instead attend the lecture that will also be **broadcast live on Facebook**.
